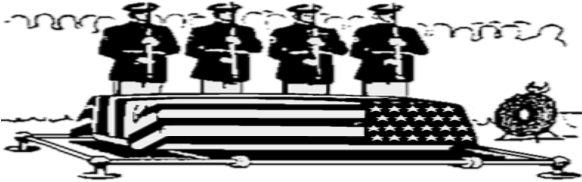

- Authorized by action of the 14th National Convention of the *American Legion* in Portland, Oregon September 12–15, 1932.
